Lady Gowrie Tasmania operates library and resource centres at:

- 'Glenora', 229 Campbell Street, Hobart
- 56 Frederick Street in Launceston.

The Library Resource Centres house a significant collection of books, current journals, videos and associated resources related to early childhood. This is a valuable resource for all early childhood professionals from centre staff and family day carers to directors, coordinators and teachers, as well as management committees, and students.

For loan there is a broad range of books, journals and periodicals, videos, CD ROMs and Learning Kits. These can be searched at <http://library.psctas.org.au/> Any resources can be requested via phone or email and reserved for collection. There is a quiet seating area for browsing, study or pre-viewing videos.

The Hobart Library is open Tuesday - Friday from 9 to 5. Opening hours are limited in Launceston and can be checked on the PSCTas website: www.psctas.org.au or by calling 1800 647 718.

A mail-out service is available to regional and remote services.

There are seven categories of membership:

Where an organisation, such as a child care centre, becomes a member, any permanent staff member of that organisation can access the Library/Resource Centre on authority or production of the membership card.

Note: Overdue items will incur a fee of \$2.00 per item.

Responsibility for damaged or lost items remains with the membership holder.
